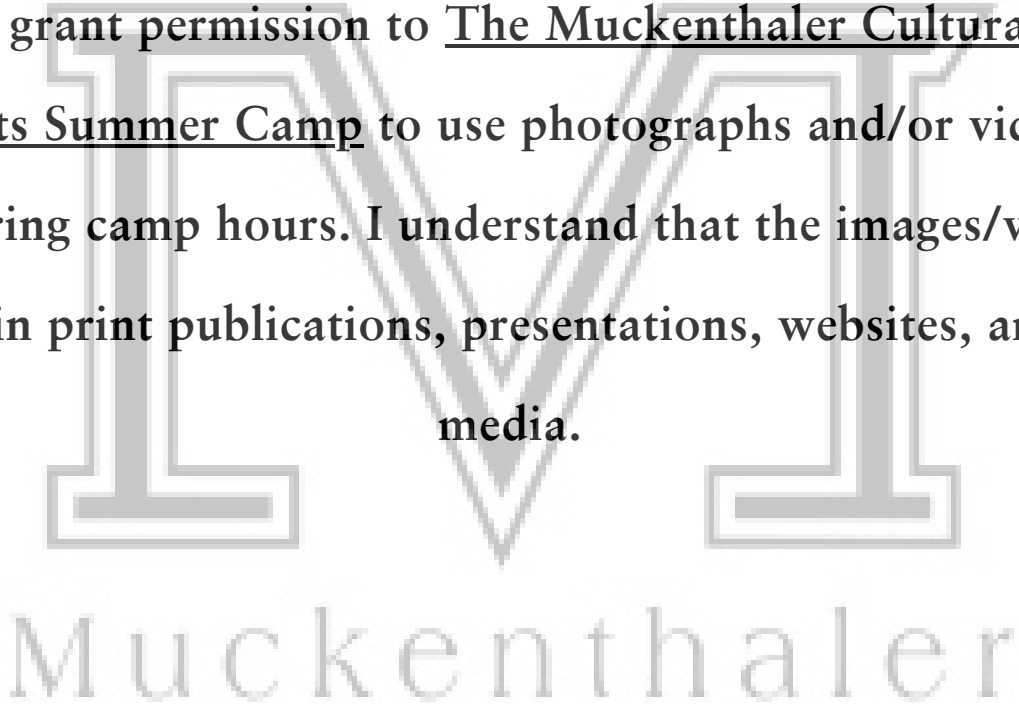

Early Drop Off/Late Pick-Up Policy

Dear Parent/Guardian,

For the safety and supervision of all children, especially during drop off and pick up times we have implemented the following:

- **No early drop-off** We ask that no student be dropped off before 8:45 am, as The Muckenthaler is in a public space, and there will be no staff available to care for the child.
- **Pick up:** If you are unable to pick up your child, please list three individuals who may pick them up. This is the order they will be called in. Be aware that these are the only individuals that will be allowed to sign out your child. If there is any change, please inform us. ID required during pick up.

- **Late Pick up:** Camp ends at 1:00 pm. Children must be picked up by 1:15 pm. Should you arrive late to pick up your child, **The late fee schedule is as follows:**

- ⇒ From 1:15-1:25 pm, the fee is \$10.00
- ⇒ \$1.00 every minute after 1:25 pm.

Staff on duty will complete a late fee payment form, which is to be signed by the parent/guardian. By signing the form, the parent/guardian acknowledges that they are late and agrees to the amount due.



Pack Daily

1. Pack a snack (Avoid easily perishable foods and glass containers)
2. Provide a bottle of water or a reusable water bottle each day.
3. Highly encourage students to bring a backpack (to keep art projects and snacks)
4. Campers bring their lunch to have during lunch/ social hour from 12:00-1:00

Attire Recommendations
